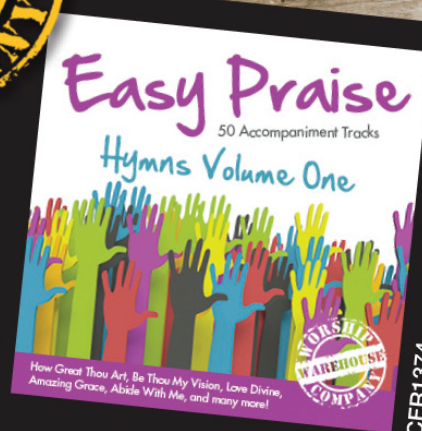

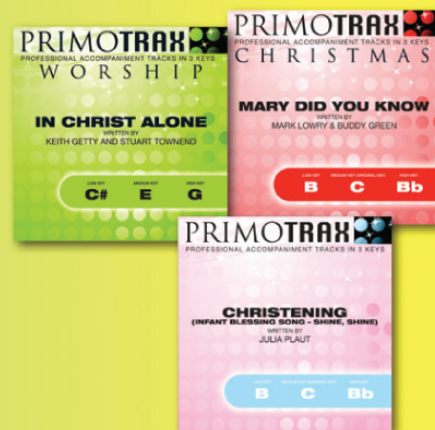

Eric is best known as the co-writer of the modern hymn, "Wonderful, Merciful Saviour," written in 1989 with his future wife, Dawn Rodgers. A widely published hymn writer, he served as the editor of The Christian Life Hymnal. As Director of Music/Organist, Eric guides the music ministry of St. Michael's Church in Charleston, South Carolina, one of the oldest Anglican churches in America. For more than a decade, he has been leading and composing for Taizé worship services, during which time he composed the songs indicated \*
